- **Novice Horse /Galloway/ Pony**—Not to have placed 1st in a similar class at any Agricultural Show or Gymkhana.

- **Show Hunters** are quality animals showing a little more substance and boldness of movement than is required for show horses. Must wear Hunter attire and have plain browband
- Show Hunters are not eligible to compete in open ridden classes.
- Once a ridden horse or rider has won a Champion in one open ring he/she are not eligible to compete in height or age class in another open ring.
- Height certificates must be produced if requested.
- Pony club riders are welcome to participate in the open rings in their pony club uniform – please note EA rules require rider classes' under18 years to present in open rings in short boots
